




The rocket and the astronaut by Janeta

Her name is Clara. She is French. She speaks French. She is James' friend.


She is 8 years old too!

James: -OK, let's try! Let's go and meet UMCs: Unidentified Moon


Creatures!»




Clara and James dreaming - by Alice

James dreaming - by Arthur




James dreaming - by Linie

James tries to put out the fuse... but he burns himself!




The rocket- by Kilian B.




Ready to take off- by Hugo

They are now ready to go. They are ready to go to the Moon. It is the countdown:




The trip to the Moon is long but it is certainly not boring.

In the rocket, Clara and James often look at some information on the computers in the rocket cabin.




Computers in the rocket cabin – Marie-Lou

James always listens to radio programs talking about the Moon.




Listening to the radio – by Théo

Clara sometimes watches the stars by the rocket window.




Watching by the rocket window- by Ophélie

Every day they go out of the rocket and space walk.




Spacewalking- by Emma

When they get back on their feet, they are very surprised: they can see a wonderful beautiful space city with tall buildings, red antennas and green lights in every direction.


There are also small spaceships flying everywhere!


« Goodbye, beautiful Moon! Don't forget us. We will come back! »
